Our Vision – to achieve excellence in safety, delivered by engaged teams

Certas Energy is committed to preventing injuries and ill health to all our colleagues and others who may be affected by our activities.

We are committed to managing and reducing our HSE impacts to as low as reasonably practicable and continue to investigate new technologies to improve our safety performance.

As a minimum standard we will comply with all HSE legislation and industry codes of practice and strive to achieve industry best practice and continual improvement in our HSE performance.

SAFETY F1RST is a Certas Energy initiative to ensure safety is the first priority in everything we do.

Managers will work with colleagues to ensure that HSE considerations are given first priority at every level of planning and decision-making. Colleagues are strongly encouraged to actively participate in controlling HSE risks by reporting all unsafe situations, suggesting improvements to Certas Energy policies, procedures and to customers' premises - to prevent harm to people and the environment.

HSE performance is every colleague's responsibility and Certas Energy empowers every colleague to stop any task or activity which they believe is unsafe and may cause harm to people or the environment. This lies at the heart of our Safety F1rst principle to **STOP – THINK - ACT**

Nothing that Certas Energy does is so important that time cannot be taken to do it safely.

By adopting process safety principles, Certas Energy will take a proactive approach in identifying hazards and assessing risks to avoid, eliminate or reduce these risks to prevent incident or loss.

Our products have inherent safety and environmental hazards. We will inform and advise our customers of the practical measures which can be taken to safely handle, store and use the products we supply.

Certas Energy recognises the environmental impacts of our business and is committed to integrating energy considerations into all business decisions. We recognise the occurrence of climate change, and therefore commit to continually reduce our carbon intensity year on year. We have established carbon footprint and energy use targets:

- Reducing our carbon footprint per litre of fuel delivered by 5% by 2020 from a baseline set on 31 March 2015.
- Our overall energy target is an annual reduction of 2% of fuel per kilometre driven from a baseline set on 31 March 2016.

A comprehensive Integrated Management System is in place to identify, assess and control the HSE risks arising from our activities.

This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it stays relevant and appropriate to Certas Energy objectives and activities.
